Hebrew word for **Voice is קול (pronounced kol)**. It is a versatile noun that is used in both ancient and modern Hebrew to mean voice, sound, or even noise the word is also used to mean "**vote**".

In Hebrew, there isn't just one word for God, but several names that reflect His different attributes. The most common term for God as Creator and ruler is **Elohim**, plural (literally meaning "gods" or "divine beings"). The personal, proper name of God is the YHWH, and in everyday speech, people often simply say HaShem which means "The Name,"

## **Hearing the Voice of God:**

### **Noah:**

Genesis 7:1 Then the Lord said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you are righteous before me in this generation.

### **Job:**

Then the Lord spoke to Job out of the storm. He said: 2 "Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge? 3 Brace yourself like a man; I will question you, and you shall answer me.

Job 37:4-5 After it his voice roars; he thunders with his majestic voice, and he does not restrain the lightnings when his voice is heard. God thunders wondrously with his voice; he does great things that we cannot comprehend.

### **Abraham:**

Genesis 12:1-3 The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

### **Jacob:**

Genesis 35: 1, 9-10 God spoke to Jacob: "Go back to Bethel. Stay there and build an altar. 9-10 God revealed himself once again to Jacob, after he had come back from Paddan Aram and blessed him: "Your name is Jacob (Heel); but that's your name no longer. From now on your name is Israel (God-Wrestler)."

**Moses:**

Exodus 3:2-3 2 There an angel of the Lord appeared to him from a burning bush. Moses saw that the bush was on fire, but it was not burning up. 3 “This is strange!” he said to himself. “I’ll go over and see why the bush isn’t burning up.” 4 When the Lord saw Moses coming near, he called him by name from the bush, and Moses answered, “Here I am.” 5 God replied, “Don’t come any closer. Take off your sandals—the ground where you are standing is holy.

3 Then Moses said to God, “Suppose I go to the People of Israel and I tell them, ‘The God of your fathers sent me to you’; and they ask me, ‘What is his name?’ What do I tell them?”

14 God said to Moses, “I-AM-WHO-I-AM. Tell the People of Israel, ‘I-AM sent me to you.’”

Exodus 15:26 Saying, “If you will diligently listen to the voice of the Lord your God, and do that which is right in his eyes,

Deuteronomy 28:2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God.

**Joshua:**

Joshua 1:5 No one will be able to defeat you all your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forget you.

**Samuel:**

1 Samuel 1:1 3 A third time the Lord called, “Samuel!” And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, “Here I am 10 The Lord came and stood there, calling as at the other times, “Samuel! Samuel!”

1 Samuel 10:1 Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured it on his head and kissed him and said, “Has not the Lord anointed you to be prince over his people Israel?”

**Elijah:**

1 Kings 18:38 Then the fire of the Lord fell and consumed the burnt offering and the wood and the stones and the dust and licked up the water that was in the trench.

1 Kings 19:11-13 And he said, “Go out and stand on the mount before the Lord.” And behold, the Lord passed by, and a great and strong wind tore the mountains and broke in pieces the rocks before the Lord, but the Lord was not in the wind. And after the wind an earthquake, but the Lord was not in the earthquake. And after the earthquake a fire, but the Lord was not in the fire. And after the fire the sound of a low whisper. And when Elijah heard it, he wrapped his face in his cloak and went out and stood at the entrance of the cave. And behold, there came a voice to him and said, “What are you doing here, Elijah?”

**Isaiah:**

Isaiah 6:8 Then I heard the Lord's voice, saying, "Who can I send? Who will go for us?" So I said, "Here I am. Send me!"

Isaiah 55:11 So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

**Jeremiah:**

Jeremiah 7:23-24 But this command I gave them: 'Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be my people. And walk in all the way that I command you, that it may be well with you.'

Jeremiah 33:3 Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known.

**Yeshua:**

Matthew 3:17: "And a voice from heaven said, 'This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.'"

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. And I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice.

Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me.
